

Dalhousie University Faculty of Medicine Tier 2 Canada Research Chair in Patient-Centred Outcomes Research

Dalhousie University's Department of Community Health & Epidemiology, Faculty of Medicine invites applications for a tenure stream Canada Research Chair (CRC) in Patient-Centred Outcomes Research. The successful candidate will benefit from, and strengthen, established relationships among patients, health care providers, clinicians and researchers within the Maritime Strategy for Patient Oriented Research SUPPORT Unit.

Applicants conducting patient-centred outcomes research in the areas of epidemiology, health services research or public health will be considered for this CRC position. The ideal candidate will have a strong record of independent and externally-funded research that uses quantitative research methods to evaluate health systems and health care.

Type 2 nominees to be excellent emerging world-class researchers who have demonstrated particular research creativity; have demonstrated a strong commitment to education and training of students and future researchers; have the potential to attract, develop and retain excellent trainee students and future researchers; and propose an original, innovative approach to research of high quality. Applicants who are less than 10 years from completing their highest degree and who are currently in the final stages of their graduate training may also be considered.
